### Summer Day Camp at Wheeling Park - June 14 - August 6, 2010

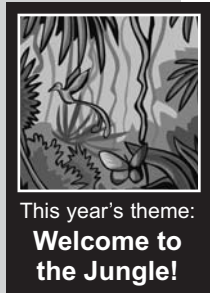

### Tennis Camps at Oglebay



The Oglebay Junior Tennis Summer Fun Camps are designed for Elementary, Middle and High School ages of all skill levels. Camps run daily, Monday through Thursday and feature on-court professional instructions in a fun environment by Marc White, our USPTA-PTR Director. Each participant will learn the fundamentals of tennis, with game base drills and modern day stroke production, along with exciting, new USTA tennis games. Sportsmanship, tennis etiquette and teamwork will also be emphasized in all camps. Camps also include the Director's Tip of the Day. All of this combined helps participants make rapid improvements while having the tennis experience of a lifetime!

The cost is \$125.00 per child for the 4-day tennis camp, which includes 10 hours of instruction, free use of demo rackets and camp graduation party. Clinic times may be adjusted and our indoor tennis bubble at Wheeling Park may be used in the event of inclement weather.

The tennis camp has several skill levels: Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced, High School Team, and Tournament Player and is offered the following weeks.

*Ground lessons cover safety, special equipment & first aid.*

**Level 4:** Open to students who have completed all other levels and are starting to canter.

*Ground lessons cover safety, different disciplines & gaits.*
