



## ALL NEW SUMMER CAMPS

Through hands-on activities, experiments and live animals, participants will learn about wildlife, nature, science and the outdoors! Camps are available for ages 4 – 15 years. Most camp programs are from 9 am – 3 pm with before and aftercare available. The zoo's experienced education staff teaches these ALL-NEW programs! The zoo's education staff are trained in CPR and first aid. Lifeguards are on duty for all swimming activities. Camp sizes are limited so register early!

### Before & After Care Available!

Before and after care is available Monday through Friday from 7:45 am – 9 am and 3 pm – 5:30 pm. Activities for before and after care include games, hikes, art projects, movies etc. The cost for before and after care is \$5 per hour for the first child and \$3 per hour for additional siblings. Payment for before and after care is due at the time of service. Before and after care is available for weekday programs only.

### Multiple child/camp discounts for week-long camps!

Register your child for three or more week-long camp programs and take 10% off your total camp enrollment fees (Lunch and before/after care are not eligible for the discount). Discount applies for the same child or siblings only. Sorry, friends can not be accepted for multiple camp discounts. Camps must be registered for at the same time in order to take advantage of this discount.

### Camp T-shirts

Camp T-shirts may be purchased for \$10 each. Orders for T-shirts must be received prior to August 1.

### Boxed Lunches

Snacks and drinks will be provided each day. Participants in full day programs will need to purchase the boxed lunches from the zoo or bring their own. ### Travelin' Tots

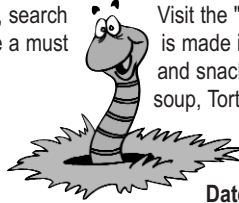

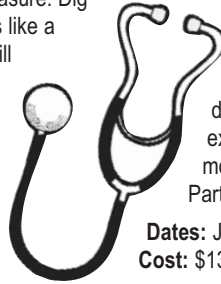
### Kitchen Science

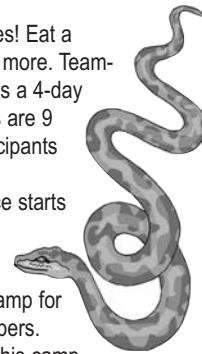

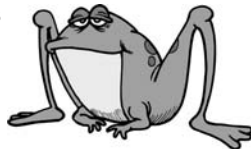


## weekend camp programs

### Cool Creatures (entering grades 2 - 4)

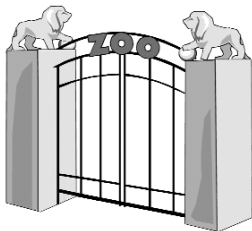
