

Safety First

- Please do not pet or feed the horses in the pastures or turnout areas. Come into the stables for a barn tour, for the safety and comfort of all guests and horses.
- All riders under the age of 18 are required to wear an ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet. Certified helmets are provided at the stables for no extra charge.
- We strongly recommend that all riders over the age of 18 wear a certified helmet (provided).
- Riders are not permitted to ride double (more than one rider per horse) at any time.
- We recommend that all riders wear long pants and boots with a low heel. No skirts, dresses or open-toed shoes.
- Riders may not use cell phones or cameras while mounted.

Later appointments may be available upon request.

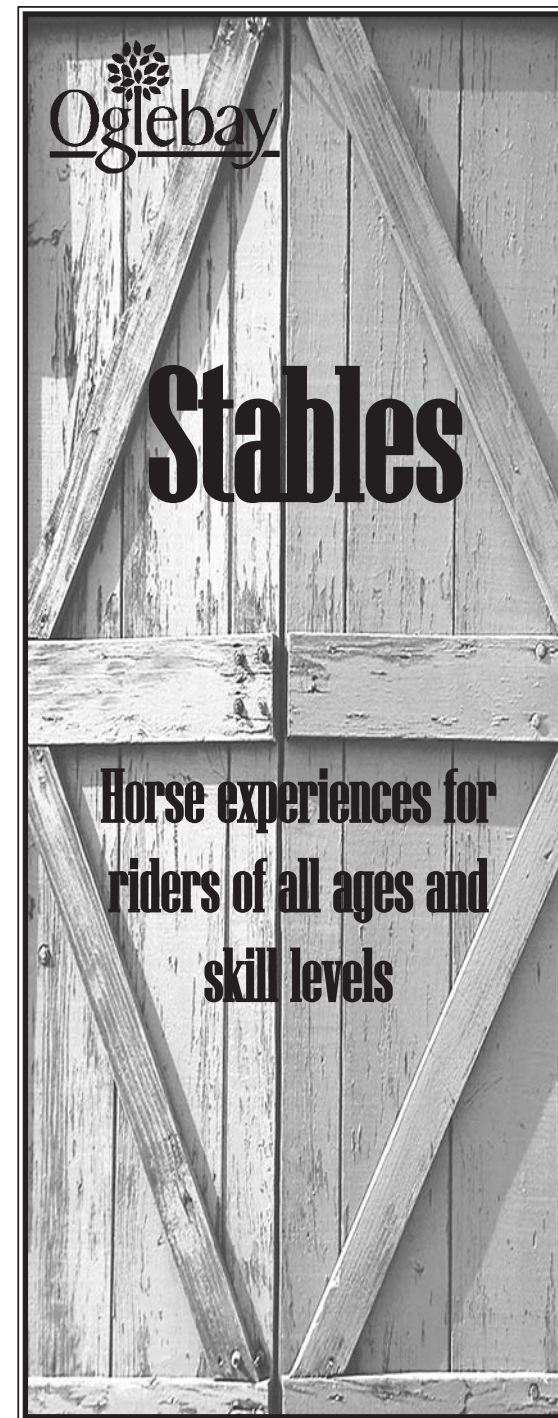
Directions

Oglebay is located in Wheeling, West Virginia on Rt. 88 N, just 4 miles off I-70 at exit 2A. The stables are located directly on Route 88, on the left.

- 1 hour from Pittsburgh via I-79 S to I-70 W to Wheeling Exit 2A.
- 2 1/2 hours from Columbus via I-70 E to Wheeling Exit 2A.
- 3 hours from Cleveland via I-77 S to I-70 E to Wheeling Exit 2A.

About Us

Oglebay is dedicated to providing enjoyable horse experiences for riders of all ages and skill levels. We offer trail rides, pony rides, lessons, therapeutic riding, camps and more. Trail rides are conducted on wide trails through the woods. All other rides take place in our indoor and outdoor riding arenas. The facility also offers a heated viewing room, lounge and bathrooms.

Eligibility

While we strive to serve every person who would like to ride, there are several requirements.

- Riders must weigh under 220 pounds.
- All riders must sign a liability release. Riders under 18 years of age will need a custodial parent or guardian to sign the BDS release. We are happy to fax or mail release forms if minors are not accompanied by a parent.
- Participants must be free of physical or mental conditions that would affect his/her safety or ability to ride a horse. For riders with special needs, see “Therapeutic Riding.”
- Any guest under 13 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.

Services

We offer many different services to meet the needs of our guests. All rides are by reservation. We recommend that you call at least 48 hours in advance, if possible.

Trail Rides

Take a relaxing, guided trail ride through the woods at Oglebay. (Trail rides are all walking.) Weather permitting. Riders must be at least 10 years of age. \$40.00*/person/hour Max. 6 riders

Lessons

Learn to ride English or Western in our indoor and outdoor arenas. All lessons include grooming and tacking up. Riders must be at least 7 years of age. Leadline lessons available for riders 4-7. Private lessons: \$35.00*/rider/hour Group lessons: \$25.00*/rider/hour

Pony Rides

Perfect for the littlest cowboys and cowgirls! Age 2 and up. \$10.00*/rider/15 minutes

Arena Rides

Riders too young or nervous to try a trail ride are welcome to ride in the arena. Age 7 and up. \$15.00*/rider/half hour Max. 4 riders

Camp

Summer and winter day camps are available. Campers learn to ride and care for horses. Camps run from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Call for dates. Ages 7-14. \$160.00*/camper/week

Therapeutic Riding

Individuals with special needs can learn to handle and/or ride horses. All sessions conducted by a NARHA certified instructor. Age 2 and up. Private sessions: \$40.00*/rider/hour \$35.00*/rider/45 min. Group sessions: \$30.00*/rider/45 min.

Barn tours

Tours of the stable are conducted during regular business hours at no charge. No reservation required.

Cancellation Policy

Riders must call to cancel at least 24 hours in advance. Riders who do not cancel will be charged the full price of the scheduled ride, except in case of emergencies.
