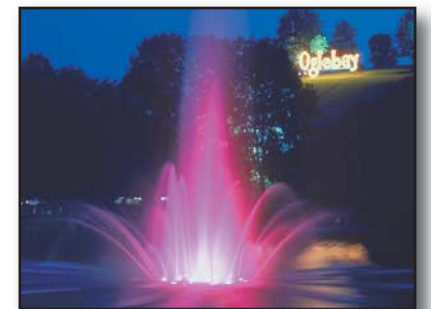
Fashion Fridays
